Membership

We have 16 active members.

Treasurer:

The flying rate is \$125/hr for the 182. Monthly dues are \$125.

Safety

The safety officer was absent from this meeting.

N199TX

The trim pieces are coming off of the door. The prop seal shows evidence of an occasional slight oil leak. It will be checked. The annual inspection will be done mid-March and the Aspen will be installed at the end of March.

Other

The winch will be wired to the hangar lights. This will ensure the winch is turned off when the hangar is closed, and will keep the cord off the hangar floor.

The club's operating rules were updated to reflect the current club aircraft and procedures. Specifically:

- I.A.14: Removed references to Mooney, Piper Archer, and Cessna 172
- I.A.15: Removed the requirement that aircraft must stop parallel to taxiway
- I.A.21: Removed rules specific to Mooney aircraft.
- III.C: Changed the location where club forms can be found. In years past, these were kept at the ASI counter. All the forms are now available on the website. Also updated the wording to allow submitting forms by methods other than mail.
- XII.A: Made the Safety Officer the contact point for members to submit their medical certificates, flight reviews, and other documents.

An amendment to the DPC constitution and by-laws was proposed. It allows the club to have non-flying "associates" who may attend the club's social functions. The specific wording of the amendment will be discussed at the February membership meeting and voted on in March.
